

Demand has exceeded available capacity




YELLOW

North America	LATAM		We are seeing backlogs into LATAM, in particular to Colombia (BOG,MDE,etc) even express service is not gaining us space.
North America	Europe		Coming out of the holiday season and end of 4th qtr we are still seeing full flights..
North America	Middle East		Flights are still full, but manageable.
North America	Asia Pacific		At this time the area of concern is Thailand, rates are still hold high
North America	India		Capacity can still be an issue, especially for the larger shipments and we are seeing a small increase in rates.
North America	Africa & Turkey		Capacity is good, but carriers are still not willing to spot

Europe	North America		Capacity is constrained for winter season. Freighter connection capacity is volatile and subject to demand fluctuations. MD11's still grounded
Europe	Europe		Many short haul routes are serviced with narrowbody equipment. Alternatively, Road Feeder Service can cover the demand.
Europe	Middle East		Rates are stable, capacity remains available passenger aircrafts and freighters moving via Middle East to Asia. Some freighter capacity has been cut. Middle East carriers are growing capacity over the next years.
Europe	Asia Pacific		Outbound capacity remains available; Many Asian carriers still see an imbalanced demand for backhaul flights. Rates hold a low level. Due to congestion in West European region, there is additional capacity deployed ex airports in Eastern Europe airports.
Europe	LATAM		Passenger rates have increased while still limited trans-Atlantic maindeck capacity available in the market. Deferred flights are available at lower costs. MD-11 Grounding impacts the capacity into Latam
Europe	Africa & Turkey		Rates are at a stable level, capacity is available out of Europe, demand is expected to remain stable for next months.
Europe	India		Despite connectivity increases, demand is now outgrowing the capacity. Rates are still at the lower side, but significantly increasing compared to last summer.

Asia	USA		Demand outpacing capacity levels with rates trending upwards
Asia	Europe		Demand is up compounded with Red Sea crisis pushing rates Northwards.
Asia	Middle East		Adequate capacity but transhipment traffic putting pressure on available capacity and rates
Asia	Intra-Asia & India		Adequate capacity but minimal WB capacity available. Asian carriers displacing lower yielding Intra Asia volumes for higher yielding Trans-Pacific loads via their hubs putting pressure on rates
Asia	Africa & Turkey		Airlines like ET/TK increasing capacity to Africa/Turkey, but demand and rates outstrip capacity for the time being
Asia	LATAM		Minimal capacity available ex APAC and first leg access to EU/US a major challenge. Rates to LATAM are rocketing and continues to be a lucrative segment ex APAC.

Middle East	LATAM		The combination of decreased capacity from the Middle East and increased demand in Latin America suggests potential upward pressure on rates.
Middle East	North America		Elevated rates and dynamic capacity adjustments, influenced by e-commerce growth, geopolitical tensions, and disruptions in maritime shipping routes. Strategic planning and flexibility are essential to navigate this complex landscape effectively.
Middle East	Europe		Spot rates from the UAE to Europe are falling as carriers offer more available space.
Middle East	Asia Pacific		Elevated rates and dynamic capacity adjustments, influenced by e-commerce growth, geopolitical tensions, and disruptions in maritime shipping routes. Strategic planning and flexibility are essential to navigate this complex landscape effectively.
Middle East	India		Middle Eastern carriers are expanding their freighter fleets and optimizing routes to meet the growing demand on key trade lanes, including those connecting to India.
