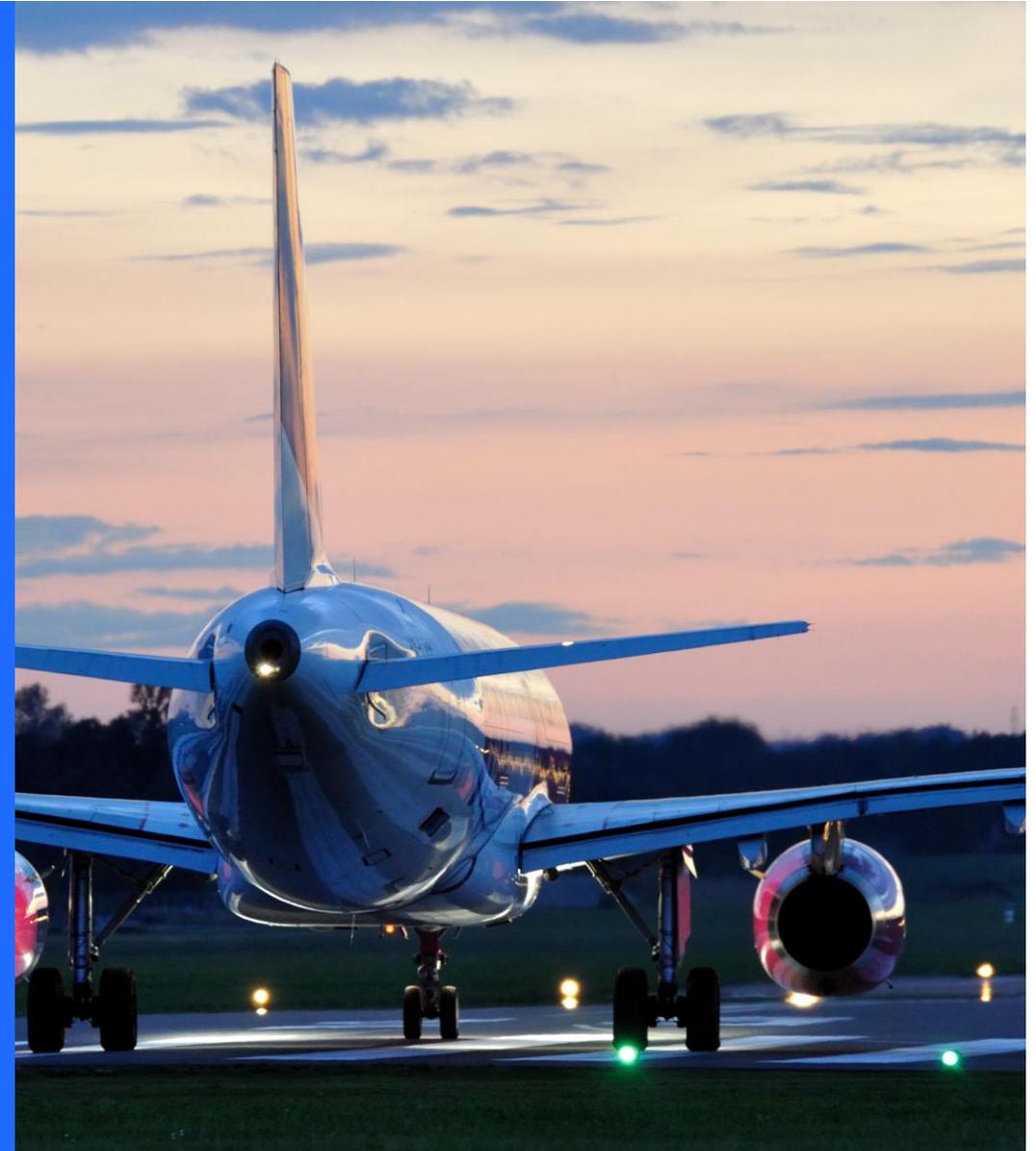

North America	LATAM		We are seeing air freight rates holding, but surcharges are going up.
North America	Europe		Carriers are willing to spot, but are not willing to take loses. Note that we are seeing increase from carriers that work on a ++ base
North America	Middle East		Due to conflict rates are changing every day
North America	Asia Pacific		Singapore and Thailand are still the ones with the higher rates.
North America	India		Rates are have gone up, due to the conflict in the middle east and the amount of carriers that have been affected. i.e. EK, EY, QR
North America	Africa & Turkey		Capacity is good into Turkey, but carries such as TK are not willing to provide lower pricing.

Europe	North America		Capacity is constrained for winter season. Midwest faces severe weather issues. On top of that, recently a short LH strike caused backlog. Freighter capacity is limited and fully allocated to tech industry. MD11's are still grounded
Europe	Europe		Many short haul routes are serviced with narrowbody equipment. Alternatively, Road Feeder Service can cover the demand.
Europe	Middle East		Ramadan season is expected to slow down the industrial demand. After the attacks, most of the airspace is closed. Highly limited options for traffic into the region. We are monitoring developments daily.
Europe	Asia Pacific		Asian carriers continue seeing an imbalanced demand for backhaul flights. As many capacity from Gulf carriers has been pulled from the market, rates are increasing. Carriers are implementing higher fuel and war risk surcharges
Europe	LATAM		Passenger rates have increased while still limited trans-Atlantic maindeck capacity available in the market. Deferred flights are available at lower costs. MD-11 Grounding impacted the capacity into Latam
Europe	Africa & Turkey		Rates are at a stable level, capacity is available out of Europe, Demand is expected to remain climb up towards harvest season, creating a capacity surplus into Africa.
Europe	India		Continued growing demand into Sub Indian continent has outgrown the capacity. Considering the input of the middle east transit hub, capacity has significantly reduced. Rates are at premium levels

Asia	USA		Demand outpacing capacity levels with rates trending upwards
Asia	Europe		Demand is up compounded with Red Sea crisis pushing rates Northwards.
Asia	Middle East		Adequate capacity but transshipment traffic putting pressure on available capacity and rates
Asia	Intra-Asia & India		Adequate capacity but minimal WB capacity available. Asian carriers displacing lower yielding Intra Asia volumes for higher yielding Trans-Pacific loads via their hubs putting pressure on rates
Asia	Africa & Turkey		Airlines like ET/TK increasing capacity to Africa/Turkey, but demand and rates outstrip capacity for the time being
Asia	LATAM		Minimal capacity available ex APAC and first leg access to EU/US a major challenge. Rates to LATAM are rocketing and continues to be a lucrative segment ex APAC.

Middle East	LATAM		Due to the current situation and airspace restrictions the flight operation is suspended in DXB / DWC / SHJ / AUH / DOH / KWI / BAH / DMM airports until Monday March 2nd, while MCT / RUH / JED / AMM / BEY / BGW / EBL still operate with restriction on destinations and experiencing heavy flight cancellation
