Egypt	Open	Functioning as the western gateway for the southern bypass routing.	N/A
Iran	Closed	Total airspace closure for all civil operations, until further notice.	Until further notice
Iraq	Closed	Total airspace closure for all civil operations, until further notice.	Until further notice
Israel	Restricted	Civil airspace closed; very limited, "Prior Permission Required" (PPR) arrivals for state/emergency flights.	Until further notice
Jordan	Open	Operational. However, it is experiencing significant delays and flow control measures.	Until further notice
Kuwait	Closed	Total airspace closure, until further notice.	Until further notice
Lebanon	Open	Lebanese airspace is open to civil aviation. However, it is under severe operational strain and high-risk warnings.	N/A
Oman	Open	Primary hub for the southern bypass. Heavily utilized, but seeing increased tactical delays and GNSS interference.	N/A
Qatar	Restricted	Qatar Airways resumed a restricted schedule using specific approved corridors.	Until further notice
Saudi Arabia	Open	Open; heavily used as reroute corridor, ATC congestion/delays possible.	N/A
Syria	Closed	Effectively closed; only partial reopening of Aleppo Airport for some northern routes, reviewed daily.	Until further notice
United Arab Emirates	Restricted	UAE airspace has partially reopened with a limited number of flights operation.	Review daily

Kuwait Airways	Restricted	Kuwait Airways has implemented a revised operational plan using DMM Saudi Arabia as a hub to limited destination.	Subject to Change
Oman Air	Open / Congested	Oman Air has begun limited and specific resumption of its flight to DMM, RUH, JED and AMM. Continued suspension to DXB, DOH, BAH, KWI, KHS.	Subject to Change

Royal Jordanian	Restricted	Operational from Amman to select destinations, flights are experiencing frequent "snap" delays or rerouting to avoid volatile airspace.	Until further notice
Saudia Cargo	Restricted	Riyadh (RUH) and Jeddah (JED) hubs are operational, but regional airspace restrictions are forcing significant rerouting. However, BAH, KWI, DOH remained suspended	Until further notice
Air France KLM	Suspended	Flights to Dubai/Riyadh suspended until 19th April. Tel Aviv/Beirut suspended until 4th April.	Until further notice
Cargolux	Suspended	Temporary suspension of all freight bound for the Middle East, with the sole exception of Muscat (MCT).	Until further notice
Cathay Group	Suspended	All flights to Dubai and Riyadh are suspended until April 30, 2026.	Until further notice
China Cargo	Suspended	Maintaining limited operations into non-conflict zones but avoiding the central Middle East corridor.	Until further notice
Lufthansa Cargo	Suspended	Flights to Dubai, Tel Aviv are suspended until May 31st.. Tehran, Amman, Abu Dhabi, Beirut, Damman, Erbil, Muscat, Riyadh are suspended through October 24th.	Until further notice
Singapore Airlines	Suspended	Avoiding Iranian and Iraqi airspace; significant delays on Europe-Asia routes due to "Northern" or "Southern" bypasses. Middle East flights are suspended.	Until further notice
Turkish Cargo	Suspended	Most flights to/from UAE, Qatar, Kuwait, Bahrain, and Saudi Arabia are suspended until April 30, 2026.	Until further notice
